



**FREE SPORTS AND CAMP PHYSICALS
FOR MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL**

Sports physicals will be provided at Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare located at 15 Council-Moore Rd., by local physicians and clinicians on *May 17 from 9:00-12:00*. This will enable middle and high school students, including rising 6th graders, to participate in Florida High School Athletic Association events for the summer and upcoming year. Of course, students may also have their sport physicals performed by their own primary care physician through normal scheduling procedures. Students will be served on May 17th in the order that they sign in. In order to avoid a long wait, Wakulla High School football players will be served beginning at 9:00; Riversprings and Wakulla Middle Schools beginning at 10:00 and other Wakulla High school students beginning at 11:00. If students arrive at a time not designated for their school, they will be worked in after students from the school are served. Families with siblings at two schools may choose the most convenient time and bring both students.

If you plan to participate, please visit your school athletic director to sign up and pick up a Pre-participation Physical Evaluation form and complete page 1 prior to arriving. Rising 6th graders should call middle schools to get on their list. The form must be signed by a parent/guardian if the student is under 18. Physicals will be performed at no charge and parents do not have to accompany students if page 1 of the physical form is completed. For more information call your school athletic director. Physicals will also be provided for Special Olympic athletes and students attending summer camps. If the physical is for a camp, the required camp form must be provided by the student.
